2021 Hunter's Moon Chenin Blanc

This year I had an interesting prospect, as we had botrytis set in for a lovely repeat of last year's Hunter's Moon, but the non-botrytis grapes were long in letting their flavors show. So we waited. We finally picked all the Chenin blanc on the same day, October 20, happily the same day we picked in 2020.

We picked in two passes. All the non-botrytised fruit went in one press load for the Hope Well Chenin Blanc. The botrytised fruit, a tiny fraction of the whole, went into the press on top of the stems of the first pass so that we could get as much juice as possible, yielding a exactly two barrels of 2021 Hunter's Moon Chenin Blanc.

The two Chenin blancs of 2021 are two very different expression of energy and tension. Their love and longing for the moon is in the aromatics of ozone and salt, the brine and electricity that crackles, and even the golden tears they leave in the glass.
